

Preparing files for upload

If uploading directly from a phone or tablet, you will probably need to compress the video first, so that it meets the size criteria for the online portal. There are many apps that can help you do this. Here are a few recommendations – please note that access to these may depend on your location.

Labelling your video files for upload

Your file should be labelled with your name, subject (and instrument for music), and grade/diploma level:

- Yourname_Classical(instrument)_Grade(number)
- Yourname_Classical(instrument)_Diploma(ATCL / LTCL)
- Yourname_R&P(instrument)_Grade(number)
